

## Print Screen Tutorial

Want to get a picture from the Internet that is not a picture? Use Print Screen & Paint to get it. Just follow these simple steps.

1. Find your Image online. On the top right of the keyboard is a key that says Print Screen. Press that key and the computer will take a "picture" of what is on the screen.
2. Open up Paint, go to the Edit tab and click "Paste". You will paste your screen shot into Paint.



3. Click on the outlined square icon "Select" on the left side of the screen. Then drag the cursor over the area you want to select to make your picture.



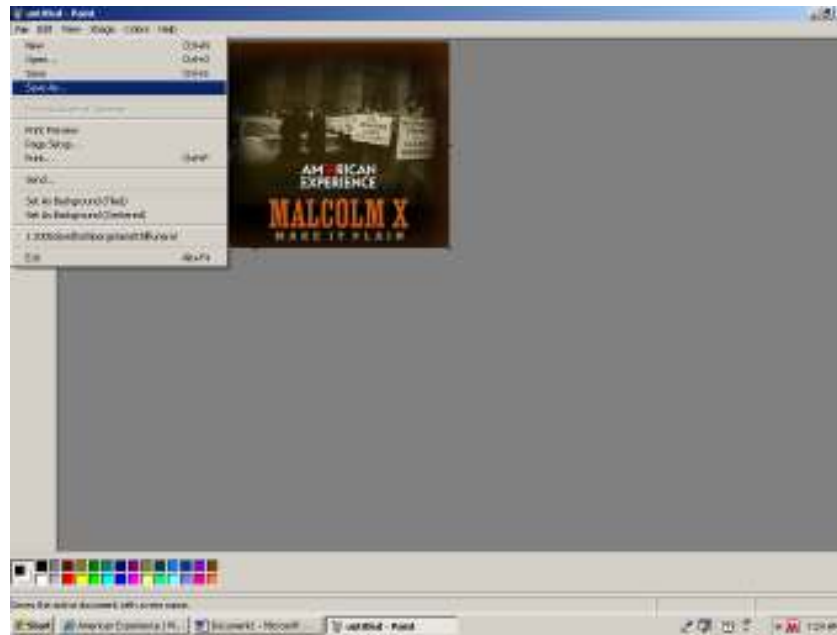
4. Go to the Edit Tab and click on Copy. You are now making a copy of just the area you have selected inside the square.



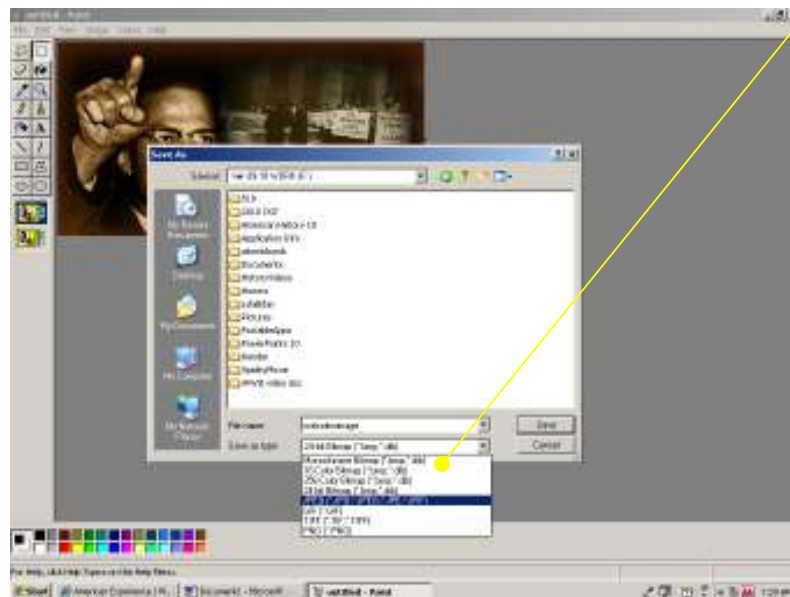
5. Go to File and open up a new Paint, go to Edit and click on Paste. Your Selected image from your Screen Shot is now ready to be made into a JPEG image. If there is any white area around your picture drag from the bottom right corner and frame your image so that no white area is showing.



6. Go to File & click Save As



7. Be sure to save your file to your flash drive! Name your file & BE SURE TO SELECT TO SAVE THE FILE AS A .JPEG IMAGE!



The image will now be saved as a .JPEG on your flash drive and you will be able to import it into Windows Movie Maker and use it in your movie!
